



Navigating the Roundabout at Route 15 and Route 53


Rules for Motorists in Single Lane Roundabouts

- Slow down before entering the roundabout.
- Signs and pavement markings will direct you.
- Yield to circulating traffic, pedestrians, bicyclists and large trucks.
- Wait for a safe gap in traffic before entering the roundabout.
- Exit the roundabout by turning right on your destination road.



Bicyclists

- If comfortable riding with traffic, you may ride in the roundabout circle while following the same traffic rules as motorists. Otherwise, use the shared use path.
- Communicate to drivers using hand signals.
- Dismount and walk your bicycle like a pedestrian when using crosswalks or sidewalks.



Pedestrians

- Cross only at designated crosswalks and use designated sidewalks at all times.
- Never cross at the central island.
- Watch for vehicles and bicyclists; you have the right-of-way, but it is advised to pay attention to all oncoming traffic.
- Cross the road one lane at a time, pausing at the splitter island to watch for oncoming traffic.
