Public Meeting



PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The primary purpose of this project is to beautify the landscape along the I-95 corridor at the Boulevard Street interchange. The landscaping will include improvements at interstate entrance and exits at mile post 78. In addition, gateway or "welcome" signs may be included at sites to be determined.

During construction, minimal traffic impacts are expected. Work will be performed within the existing right of way. No work will take place in the travel lanes.

This project is being funded through a combination of

federal and matching funds.

Previous project include the I64/Nine Mile Road interchange, the I95/ Broad Street interchange and the I95/I64/5th Street Interchange.

Limited funding is available beyond the I95/ Boulevard interchange project.

Environmental Review

Federal funding is being proposed for construction of this project. Therefore, environmental investigations under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) will be conducted.

Right of Way

The project does not anticipate the acquisition of any right of way or easements.
