

**Route 627 (Reliance Road)
Through Truck Traffic Restrictions
Frederick & Warren Counties**

Notice is hereby given that the Virginia Department of Transportation is accepting written comments through March 5, 2018, regarding the restriction of through truck traffic along Route 627 (Reliance Road) in Frederick and Warren counties.

The proposed 6.0-mile restricted section of Route 627 (Reliance Road) will begin one mile east of the Interstate 81 exit 302 (Route 627) interchange in Frederick County and end in Warren County at the intersection of Route 340/522 (Winchester Road).

An alternate truck route is proposed to begin on Route 627 one mile east of the I-81 exit 302 (Route 627) interchange, then traveling south along I-81 to Interstate 66, then east on I-66 to the exit 6 (Route 340/522) interchange, then north along Route 340/522 ending at the intersection of Route 627. The alternate route is 11.0 miles.
