**Find out** about plans to widen existing pavement and shoulders on Route 626 from 0.02 mile south of intersection with Route 610 to 0.34 mile north of intersection with Route 610 to improve safety and address drainage issues. During construction, flaggers will assist motorists. The hearing will be held in an "open house" format and VDOT representatives will be present to answer questions.

**Review** project information and the National Environmental Policy Act document in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion (PCE) at the public hearing or after the hearing at VDOT's Lynchburg District Office located at 4219 Campbell Avenue in the City of Lynchburg, 434-947-6559, 800-FOR-ROAD (367-7623). Property impact information, relocation assistance policies and tentative construction schedules are available for your review at the above address and will be available at the public hearing.
