

PUBLIC NOTICE

THROUGH TRACTOR TRAILER TRAFFIC RESTRICTION IN MONTGOMERY/ROANOKE COUNTY

Notice is hereby given that the Virginia Department of Transportation is accepting written comments through Friday, January 12, 2018 regarding the restriction of through tractor trailer and/or semi-trailer combination traffic on Route 624 (Mount Tabor Road/Newport Road) in Montgomery and Roanoke County.

The 18.61 mile section on Route 624 will begin at the north corporate limits of the town of Blacksburg in Montgomery County, Route 624 (Mount Tabor Road/Newport Road) and ending at the Intersection of Route 311 (Catawba Valley Drive) in Roanoke County.

The alternate route proposed is Business Route 460 (North Main Street) beginning at the intersection of Mount Tabor Road and Business Route 460 (North Main Street), in the Town of Blacksburg, then traveling north on Business Route 460 (North Main Street), to Route 460, then traveling east on Route 460 to I-81, then traveling north on I-81 to Exit 140 to Route 311 (Thompson Memorial), then traveling north on Route 311 (Thompson Memorial / Catawba Valley Drive) and ending at the intersection of Route 624 (Newport Road) and Route 311 (Catawba Valley Drive). The alternative route is 47.05 miles.
