Pedestrian Improvements

Find out about the plans for a project to improve safety for pedestrians, bicyclists and motorists with installation of 435 feet of new sidewalk, entrance, curbing and crosswalks along Route 122 near the Bedford Welcome Center. Crosswalks and sidewalks also will be constructed at Tiger Trail and Overlord Circle.

Review the project information and National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentation in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at VDOT's Salem District Office located at 731 Harrison Ave. in Salem, 540-387-5353, 800-FOR-ROAD (367-7623), TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Mr. Mark McKissick, PE, Virginia Department of Transportation, 731 Harrison Avenue, Salem, VA 24153 on or prior to **July 27, 2017**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
