



Route 52 (Poplar Camp Road) Safety Improvements Carroll County

Find out about a project to improve curves at two locations along 0.651 mile of Route 52 in Carroll County. The curve at the Route 770 (Hanging Tree Road) intersection will be realigned and six foot shoulders added. In addition, the side slopes at the Route 705 (Coon Ridge Road) intersection will be cut back to improve the sight distance.

Review the project information at VDOT's Salem District Office located at 731 Harrison Ave. in Salem, 540-387-5353, 800-FOR-ROAD (367-7623), TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions.

National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentation in the form of a Categorical Exclusion will be completed and available for review at VDOT's Salem District Office within 45 days of expiration of this notice.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Mr. C.E. Cumbie, Virginia Department of Transportation, 731 Harrison Avenue, Salem, VA 24153 on or prior to **August 3, 2017**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
