Find out about proposed improvements on Route 3 that will add passing lanes in both directions from north of Winter Harbour Road (Route 639) to east of Longwood Road (Route 624) in Westmoreland County. Improvements include the proposed construction of passing lanes in each direction by providing approximately 4,400 feet of 4-lane segment of roadway and left turns eastbound at Route 624 and westbound at Route 761. The total approximate length of the project is 1.6 miles. Plans for these improvements will be available for public view at the hearing.

Stop by between 5-7 p.m. to review the proposed plans and the prepared National Environmental Policy Act document. Project plans are available for review at VDOT's Fredericksburg District Office at 87 Deacon Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22405. Please call 540-899-4288 ahead of your visit to ensure appropriate personnel are available to answer your questions.

Property impact information, relocation assistance policies and tentative construction schedules are available for your review at the District Office and will be available at the public hearing.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed project on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places is provided in the environmental documentation.
