Find out about the proposed replacement of the Route 658 (Tilley's Bridge Road) bridge over the South Fork Holston River in Smyth County. During replacement, the bridge will be closed for approximately nine months to expedite construction.

Review the proposed project plans and environmental document in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at the VDOT Bristol District Office located at 870 Bonham Road in Bristol, VA, 276-669-6151, 800-367-7623, TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to **Mr. David Lively, VDOT Bridge Project Manager**, 870 Bonham Road, Bristol, Virginia, 24201, prior to **July 26, 2017**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
