



Route 460 Ramp Construction Town of Christiansburg

Find out about the plans to construct a new ramp from the eastbound Route 460 Bypass ramp to westbound Franklin Street (Route 460 Business) in Christiansburg. This new ramp will provide new access from eastbound Route 460 to a retail area.

Review the project information and National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentation in the form of a Categorical Exclusion at VDOT's Salem District Office located at 731 Harrison Ave. in Salem, 540-387-5353, 800-FOR-ROAD (367-7623), TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Mr. Tim Dowdy, Virginia Department of Transportation, 731 Harrison Avenue, Salem, VA 24153, on or prior to **August 3, 2017**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
