Find out about a proposed project to replace the Route 240 (Crozet Avenue) bridge over Lickinghole Creek in Albemarle County. The existing bridge was built in 1921 and is considered structurally deficient. VDOT will present two construction alternatives with respective schedules and traffic impacts for public input.

Review the proposed project plans and the National Environmental Policy Act documentation in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at the public hearing or at VDOT's Culpeper District Office located at 1601 Orange Road in Culpeper, VA, 540-829-7500 and VDOT's Charlottesville Residency, located at 701 VDOT Way, Charlottesville, VA, 434-293-0011, or 1-800-367-7623, TTY/TDD 711.
