



## **Route 11 (Williamson Road) and Route 117 (Peters Creek Road) Pedestrian Safety Improvements Roanoke County**

**Find out** about a project to provide pedestrian improvements along a 0.45-mile section of Route 11 (Williamson Road) that crosses Route 117 (Peters Creek Road) near Hollins in Roanoke County. The project will extend the existing curb and gutter and add 2,240 feet of sidewalk along southbound Williamson Road and 110 feet on the west side of Peters Creek Road at the Williamson Road intersection. In addition, pedestrian signals and crosswalks will be added to the intersection of Williamson Road and Peters Creek Road.

**Review** the project information and National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentation in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at VDOT's Salem District Office located at 731 Harrison Ave. in Salem, 540-387-5353, 800-FOR-ROAD (367-7623), TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Mr. Tim Dowdy, Virginia Department of Transportation, 731 Harrison Avenue, Salem, VA 24153 on or prior to **June 27, 2019**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
