Find out about plans to reconstruct Route 682, Woody's Lake Road from Business Route 29 to 0.900 miles east of Business Route 29, a length of 0.900 miles. During construction, traffic will be maintained along Route 682 at all times. The intersection of Route 682 and Trojan Road will be closed temporarily; however, traffic will be maintained in all directions with a short term detour. The hearing will be held in an "open house" format and VDOT representatives will be present to answer questions.

Review project information and the National Environmental Policy Act document in the form of a Categorical Exclusion at the public hearing or after the hearing at VDOT's Lynchburg District Office located at 4219 Campbell Avenue in the City of Lynchburg. Property impact information, relocation assistance policies and tentative construction schedules are available for your review at the above address and will be available at the public hearing.
