**Find out** about the proposed improvements at three locations along the Route 17 Corridor in the Town of Tappahannock in Essex County.

The proposed project includes intersection improvements at Route 17 and Route 360 (Queen Street), Route 17 and Route 725 (Winston Road) and shoulder improvements on Route 17 from Route 1030 (Richmond Beach Road) to Route 698 (White Oak Road).

Property impact information, relocation assistance policies and tentative construction schedules will be available for review at the public hearing and also at the VDOT offices listed above.
