



**Proposed  
Through Truck Restriction  
Route 1021 (Azalea Road)  
Botetourt County**

Notice is hereby given that the Virginia Department of Transportation is soliciting written comments through **August 31, 2020** regarding a potential restriction of through truck traffic along Route 1021 (Azalea Road) in Botetourt County.

The potential 0.56-mile restricted section of Route 1021 (Azalea Road) starts at the intersection of Route 779 (Catawba Road) and ends at the intersection of US Route 220 (Roanoke Road).

A potential alternate truck route begins on Route 779 (Catawba Road), at the intersection of Route 1021 (Azalea Road), and advances east to US Route 220 (Roanoke Road) where it then continues south along US Route 220 (Roanoke

Road), ending at the intersection of Route 1021 (Azalea Road). The potential alternate route is 0.68 miles in length.
