**Find out** about plans to add turn lanes on Route 60, W. James Anderson Hwy at Route 56, James River Highway. The project limits are from 0.194 miles west to 0.151 miles west of Route 56, a length of 0.345 miles. During construction, one lane of traffic will be maintained at all times with temporary lane closures using traffic control devices. The hearing will be held in an “open house” format and VDOT representatives will be present to answer questions.

**Review** project information and the National Environmental Policy Act document in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at the public hearing or after the hearing at VDOT’s Lynchburg District Office located at 4219 Campbell Avenue in the City of Lynchburg. Property impact information, relocation assistance policies and tentative construction schedules are available for your review at the above address and will be available at the public hearing.
