The purpose of the study is to help Franklin County and VDOT to identify strategies to preserve capacity, enhance safety and support future growth along this significant corridor in Franklin County. Preliminary design concepts include restricting and closing median crossovers, restricting or removing intersection turning movements and modifying traffic signals.
