Find out about proposed plans to replace the bridge and approaches on US 29 North over Norfolk-Southern Railway in Campbell County. Temporary lane closures will be in place during construction of tie-ins, crossover and entrances, placement of bridge beams and demolition of the existing structure; otherwise, two lanes of traffic will be maintained in either direction. The project limits are from 0.50 miles north of Route 683 to 1.002 miles north of Route 683. The hearing will be held in an "open house" format and VDOT representatives will be present to answer questions.

Review project information and the National Environmental Policy Act document in the form of a Categorical Exclusion at the public hearing or after the hearing at VDOT's Lynchburg District Office located at 4219 Campbell Avenue in the City of Lynchburg. Property impact information, relocation assistance policies and tentative construction schedules are available for your review at the above address and will be available at the public hearing.
