



## Route 221 (Floyd Highway) Bridge Replacement Floyd County

**Find out** about the proposed plans for a project to replace the Route 221 bridge over Mira Fork in Floyd County. The bridge is located at Route 221's intersection with Route 761 (Mira Fork Road NW). The proposed project entails the replacement of the aging existing bridge with a more modern structure that meets current standards.

**Review** the project information and National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentation in the form of a Categorical Exclusion at VDOT's Salem District Office located at 731 Harrison Ave. in Salem, 540-387-5353, 800-FOR-ROAD (367-7623), TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed project on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places is provided in the project's environmental documentation.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Mr. Matt Prosser, Virginia Department of Transportation, 731 Harrison Avenue, Salem, VA 24153 on or prior to **December 15, 2016**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
