Find out about the proposed project to add dedicated turn lanes, modify the existing lanes, traffic signal upgrades and pedestrian improvements at the intersection of Route 30 and Route 360 in King William County.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, you may request that a public hearing be held for this project. The date to request a public hearing has been extended until Thursday, May 31, 2018. Written request must be sent to Ms. Anastasia Kapitan, Project Manager, Virginia Department of Transportation, 87 Deacon Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22405 by close of business, May 31, 2018. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time, and place of the hearing will be posted.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed improvements on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places are included in the National Environmental Policy Act documentation.
