at Route 620 (Harrison Road)
Turn Lane Extension Project
Spotsylvania County
Notice of Willingness**

Find out about the proposed Turn Lane Extension Project on Route 1 Business (Lafayette Boulevard) between Route 686 (Lee Street) and Route 620 (Harrison Road) in Spotsylvania County.

The project will extend the existing southbound right turn lane on Lafayette Boulevard between Lee Street and Harrison Road. This project will improve capacity and reduce delay for drivers turning right onto Harrison Road from southbound Route 1 Business (Lafayette Boulevard).

Review the project information and the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) document in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at VDOT's Fredericksburg District Office located at 87 Deacon Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22405, 540-899-4288 or TDD/TTY 711. You can also review the project information at VDOT's Fredericksburg Residency Office located at 86 Deacon Road, Fredericksburg, Virginia, 540-899-4300.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Mr. Byrd Holloway, Project Manager, Virginia Department of Transportation, 87 Deacon Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22405 on or prior to March 27, 2019. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time, and place of the hearing will be posted.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed improvements on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places are included in the National Environmental Policy Act documentation.
