

## **U.S. Route 460/58/13 Connector Study Chesapeake and Suffolk Public Survey**

The study area being evaluated extends from near the Bowers Hill interchange of Interstate 664 in the City of Chesapeake to the interchange of Portsmouth Boulevard (Business U.S. Route 460) and the Suffolk Northern Bypass (U.S. Route 460/58/13) in the City of Suffolk. The study is in the planning phase and VDOT is requesting public input to identify current and future transportation needs in the study area.
