

**Route 29 Northbound Spot Widening

Find out about plans to add a third lane to northbound Route 29 (Lee Highway) in Fairfax County from just before Pickwick Road to a quarter-mile beyond the traffic signal.

The proposed project is exempt from federal eligibility and the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) does not apply. Consistent with Memorandum of Agreement created pursuant to Code of Virginia § 10.1 - 1188-B, VDOT has determined the minimal right-of-way acquisition needed will not have significant impacts to the environment and that the proposed project is exempt from the State Environmental Review Process (SERP) coordination with state environmental and historic agencies.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed improvements on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places will be available for review at the public hearing.

Stop by between 6:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. to view displays and learn about the project. VDOT staff will be available to answer your questions.
