Find out about plans to rehabilitate the historic John G. Lewis Memorial Bridge that carries Featherbed Lane (Route 673) over Catoctin Creek in order to improve safety and extend the overall life of the truss bridge.

The planned improvements include installing the existing truss above a new steel beam and timber deck bridge, adding a new bridge pier and upgrading the bridge railings.

Pursuant with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and 23 CFR 771, a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion (PCE) will be prepared under agreement with the Federal Highway Administration. The John G. Lewis Memorial Bridge is listed in the National Register of Historic Places (NHRP). In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed improvements on the historic bridge and other properties listed in or eligible for listing in the NRHP will be available at the hearing.

Stop by between 6:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. to view displays and learn more about the project. Project staff will be available to answer your questions.
