



Interstate 77 bridges over Cove Creek (Wythe County) Bridge Replacement Project

Find out about the proposed plans to replace the Interstate 77 bridges over Cove Creek in Wythe County, located between mile markers 42 and 43. During the construction project, two-lane traffic will be maintained north and southbound, with the possibility of periodic nighttime lane closures in each direction. Additionally, a shoulder closure is possible during the work.

Review the project information and National Environmental Policy Act document in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at VDOT's Bristol District Office located at 870 Bonham Road in Bristol, 276-669-6151, 1-800-FOR-ROAD, TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Mr. Haven Wright, Virginia Department of Transportation, 870 Bonham Road, Bristol, Virginia 24201, on or prior to **October 22, 2019**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
