RT. 629 TO BE CLOSED OCT. 5-14 FOR PIPE REPLACEMENT

Motorists advised to plan extra travel time, follow detour

CULPEPER — The Virginia Department of Transportation will close Route 629 (Cartersville Road) in Louisa County to replace a pipe near Route 640 (East Old Mountain Road).

The road will be closed about 0.25-mile from Route 640 from Oct. 5 until Oct. 14.

Crews will excavate the soil above and around the pipe. After removing the pipe, crews will install a new pipe, backfill the area and resurface the road.

During the closure, drivers coming from Route 522 will be detoured via Route 640 to Route 606 (Waltons Store Road) to Route 718 (Proffits Road) which carries traffic back to Route 629. Motorists coming from Interstate 64 and Route 250 will reverse the detour using Route 718 to Route 606 to Route 640.
