EXTENDED CLOSURE PLANNED ON ROUTE 618 FOR BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

A signed detour will be in place

SOUTHAMPTON COUNTY – The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will temporarily close Route 618 (Crumpler Road) at the bridge over Terrapin Swamp starting the morning of February 5, 2018 to replace the bridge. Crews plan to have the road reopened by February 23, 2018.

The construction site is north of Ivor at the intersection of Old Blackwater Road (Route 621). A signed detour will be in place throughout the extended closure as follows:

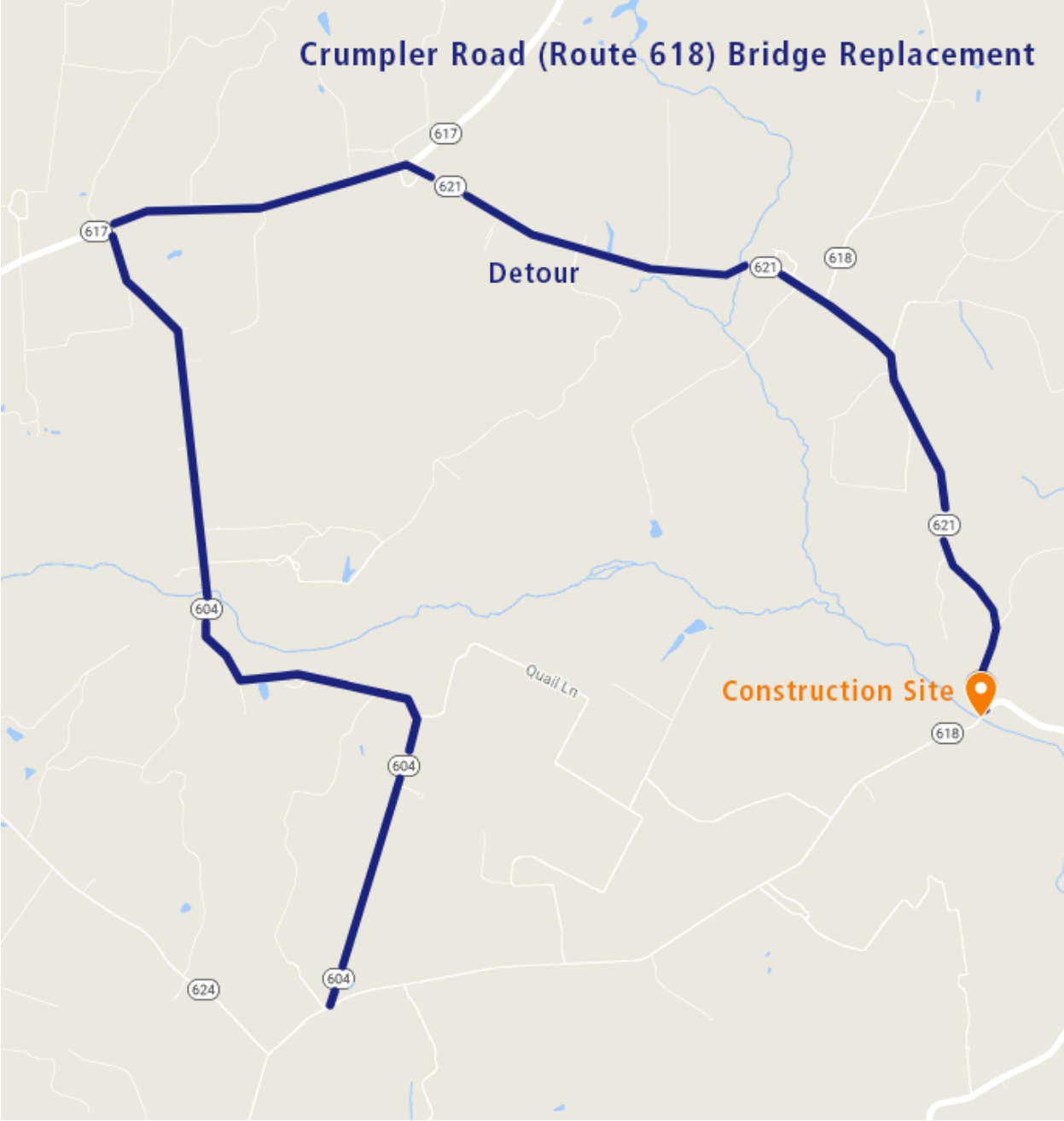
East to west:

From Old Blackwater Road (Route 621), in 0.4 miles continue onto Aberdeen Road (Route 621) for 2.8 miles. Turn left onto White Marsh Road (Route 617). In 0.95 miles turn left onto Goodrich Fork Road (Route 604). In 2.87 miles continue onto Mt. Hope Road (Route 604) for 0.1 miles. End detour.

West to east:

From Crumpler Road (Route 618) turn left onto Mt. Hope Road (Route 604). In 0.1 miles continue onto Goodrich Fork Road (Route 604). In 2.8 miles turn right onto White Marsh Road (Route 617). In 0.95 miles turn right onto Aberdeen Road (Route 621) in 2.8 miles continue onto Old Blackwater Road (Route 621) in 0.4 miles. End detour.
