DIASCUND ROAD TO CLOSE FOR PIPE REPAIR WORK

Detour will be in place during the short-term closure

JAMES CITY COUNTY– A section of Diascund Road (Route 603), starting from 1.5 miles north of Hicks Island Road (Route 601) to approximately 2 miles south of Richmond Road (Route 60), will be closed to through traffic for pipe repair work, starting as early as 8 a.m. on Tuesday, September 10. The work is estimated to be complete by the end of the week, weather permitting.

Motorists should follow the signed detour in place directing traffic to Barnes Road.
