CLAREMONT AVENUE DETOUR TO MIDTOWN TUNNEL CHANGED

Claremont Avenue ramp remains closed through summer 2016

NORFOLK – Effective today, the right turn traffic restriction from Redgate Avenue onto Hampton Boulevard will be reinstated by the City of Norfolk. The turn restriction is in effect daily Monday through Friday from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.

The new [detour](#) for the Claremont Avenue ramp is Redgate Avenue to Colley Avenue to Brambleton Avenue back to U.S. 58 toward the Midtown Tunnel.

The right turn restriction at Redgate Avenue and Hampton Boulevard was lifted in early October to accommodate motorists previously using the Claremont Avenue on-ramp to the U.S. 58 Midtown Tunnel. This ramp is currently closed for construction activities related to the [Elizabeth River Tunnels \(ERT\) Project](#) and is necessary in order to reconfigure the ramp and roadway for access to the new Midtown Tunnel. The Claremont Avenue on-ramp is scheduled to re-open summer 2016.
