## OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR I-64 WIDENING PROJECT *Sunday, October 30 – Thursday, November 3*

**NEWPORT NEWS** —For the week of Sunday, October 30, through Thursday, November 3, lane closures are scheduled on Interstate 64 as follows:

**Segment I:** Monday, October 31, through Thursday, November 3, east- and westbound single-lane closures between Fort Eustis Boulevard (exit 250) and Jefferson Avenue (exit 255), from 8 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning.

**Segment II:** Sunday, October 30, through Thursday, November 3, east- and westbound single-lane closures between Route 143 (exit 243) and Yorktown Road (exit 247), starting as early as 7 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning.

The following interstate ramps will have a single-night closure with a signed detour in place from Sunday, October 30, through November 3, starting as early as 8 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning. Only one set of ramps will close at a time.

- I-64 east on- and off-ramps to Route 199 (exit 242A)
- I-64 east on- and off-ramps at Route 143 (exit 247)
- Entrance ramp from Yorktown Road to I-64 east
- I-64 west exit ramp to Yorktown Road (exit 247)
- Entrance ramp from Route 143 (Jefferson Avenue) south to I-64 west

One travel lane in each direction will remain open to traffic at all times. All construction work is dependent upon weather conditions.

Westbound truck traffic on Interstate 64 is now restricted to the right lane between Jefferson Avenue (exit 255) and Yorktown Road (exit 247). Motorists are also advised to be alert to the reduced 55 mph work zone speed limit in this area, which will remain in effect throughout construction.

To minimize inconvenience to motorists, no daytime lane closures are planned at this time. Lane closures and construction information will be announced weekly.
