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TRAFFIC SHIFT PLANNED AT HOLLAND ROAD CONNECTION PROJECT

Motorists should be alert to new traffic pattern

VIRGINIA BEACH—As soon as Friday, May 12, 2017, drivers at the Holland Road Connection Project should expect a traffic shift, weather permitting, as construction advances.

First, drivers headed north and south on Holland Road will encounter a flagging operation while crews build crossovers. This flagging operation will be temporary.

Once the crossover work is complete, drivers headed north on Holland Road towards Dam Neck Road will shift to the new northbound section. Drivers headed south on Holland Road towards Nimmo Parkway will continue to use the old southbound span of Holland Road for about a week.



We are especially asking residents and local businesses to be aware of potential changes to the location of **STOP** signs as they turn from their neighborhoods onto Holland Road.

There will be another traffic shift to allow for work on the old southbound section. VDOT will provide details on the southbound traffic shift closer to when it is scheduled.

Construction at the Holland Road Connection Project began in November 2014 and is expected to finish in October. The purpose of this project is to increase safety and traffic flow by expanding the road from two to four lanes.
