MONTICELLO AVENUE TO CLOSE FOR EMERGENCY ROADWORK

Detour will be in place during the closure

JAMES CITY COUNTY—Monticello Avenue (Route 5000) between Centerville Road (Route 614) and John Tyler Highway (Route 5) will be closed for repair work starting at 9 a.m. on Monday, December 12, through the morning of Friday, December 23. A signed detour will be in place.

Traffic will be detoured as follows:

Westbound: Motorists will turn left at Centerville Road (Route 614), turn right onto John Tyler Highway (Route 5), and turn left at the intersection of John Tyler Highway (Route 5) and Monticello Avenue (Route 5000).

Eastbound: Motorists will turn right at the intersection of John Tyler Highway (Route 5) and Monticello Avenue (Route 5000) onto John Tyler Highway (Route 5), turn left onto Centerville Road (Route 614), and turn right onto Monticello Avenue (Route 5000).
