ROUTE 637 (JONES TOWN DRIVE) TO CLOSE FOR REPAIRS ON BRIDGE OVER RATTLESNAKE SWAMP

Detour will be in place during the closure

ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY— Crews with the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will close Route 637 (Jones Town Drive) between Route 681 (Raynor Road) and Route 646 (Rattlesnake Trail) for superstructure repairs to the bridge over Rattlesnake Swamp. The closure begins at 9 a.m. Monday, October 31, 2016, and is scheduled to be complete by 4 p.m. Friday, November 18. The scheduled work will last three weeks and is dependent upon weather conditions. Signed detours will be in place for motorists.

Traffic will be detoured as follows:

Eastbound Traffic: Follow Route 681 (Raynor Road) 1 mile. Turn left onto Route 625 (Modest Neck Road) and travel 2.4 miles. Turn left onto Route 623 (Green Level Road) and travel 1 mile. Turn left onto Route 626 (Mill Swamp Road) and travel 0.8 miles to Route 637 (Jones Town Drive) to complete the detour.

Westbound Traffic: Follow Route 637 (Jones Town Drive) for 0.8 miles. Turn right onto Route 626 (Mill Swamp Road) and travel 1 mile. Turn right onto Route 623 (Green Level Road) and travel 2.4 miles. Turn right onto Route 625 (Modest Neck Road) and travel 1 mile to Route 681 (Raynor Road) to complete the detour.
