HAMPTON ROADS WEEKLY LANE CLOSURES REPORT

For the week of November 18, 2016 through November 25, 2016

There will be no lane closures along Hampton Roads Interstates from noon Wednesday, November 23 until noon Monday, November 28 for the Thanksgiving Day Holiday

- **I-64 Widening Project, Newport News/York County:**
 - **Segment I:** There will be a 20-minute traffic stoppage on I-64 east at the Lee Hall Reservoir Bridges on November 21, November 22, and November 23 starting at 3 a.m.
 - **Segment II:** There will be westbound single-lane closures between Route 199 (exit 242-A) and Lee Hall (exit 247), on November 21-22 starting as early as 7 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning.Please check http://www.i64widening.org/news_information/traffic_alert.asp for the latest closure/detour information.
- **I-664 Monitor-Merrimac Memorial Bridge-Tunnel:** Single-lane closures northbound as follows. One lane will remain open at all times:
 - Northbound November 20 from 8 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning from College Drive to Monitor-Merrimac Memorial Bridge-Tunnel.
- **US-17 James River Bridge:** Single-lane closures southbound. One lane will remain open at all times:
 - Southbound November 21-22 from 9 a.m. until 2 p.m.
- **I-64 HOV Reversible Roadway, Norfolk:** HOV Reversible Roadway will be closed as follows:
 - November 21 from 9 a.m. until 1:30 p.m.
- **I-564 Westbound Tunnel, Norfolk:** Single-lane closures as follows. One lane will remain open at all times:
 - November 22 from 9 a.m. until 10 a.m.
- **I-64 Eastbound, Hampton:** Dual lane closures as follows. One lane will remain open at all times:

- Eastbound November 21 from 8 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning from Hampton Roads Center Parkway to I-664 southbound on-ramp.
- **Armistead Avenue I-64 West On-ramp/Off-ramp, Hampton:** The Armistead Avenue on-ramp and off-ramps to and from I-64 westbound will close nightly November 20-21 from 8 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning. A detour will be in place.
- **I-64 Westbound, York County:** Single-lane closures as follows westbound. One lane will remain open at all times:
 - Westbound November 20 from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning at VA-143 (Camp Peary).
- **I-64 Westbound, New Kent County:** Single-lane closures as follows westbound. One lane will remain open at all times:
 - Westbound November 21 from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning at VA-33 (exit 220).
- **US-17 Magruder Boulevard, York County:** Alternating lane closures northbound and southbound as follows between Darby Road and Hampton Highway. One lane will remain open at all times:
 - Northbound/Southbound November 20-21 from 7 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning.
- **VA-199 Westbound, James City County:** Alternating lane closures westbound on VA-199 westbound at VA-132. One lane will remain open at all times:
 - November 20-21 from 7 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning.
- **Military Highway Continuous Flow Intersection, Norfolk:** Alternating and single-lane closures as follows. One lane will remain open at all times:
 - November 20- 21: Alternating single-lane closures northbound and southbound from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and from 7 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning on Military Highway between Valley Drive and Lynn Street.
 - November 20-21: Alternating single-lane closures eastbound and westbound from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and from 7 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning on Princess Anne Road, between Sigmon Street and the intersection of Military Highway.
 - November 20-21: Alternating single-lane closures eastbound and westbound from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and from 7 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning on Northampton Boulevard between the intersection of Military Highway and past USAA Drive.
 - November 20-21: Alternating single-lane closures eastbound and westbound from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and from 7 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning on Robin Hood Road between Ellsmere Avenue and Miller Store Road.

- **U.S. 58, Southampton County:** Alternating lane closures eastbound and westbound on U.S. 58 between Shady Brook Trail and Old Bridge Road. One lane will remain open at all times:
 - November 21-22 from 6 a.m. until 9 p.m.
 - November 23 from 6 a.m. until 12 p.m.
- **US-13 (Lankford Highway), Accomack County:** Consecutive single-lane closures northbound between Route 179 and Taylor Road. One lane will remain open at all times:
 - September 6-December 5 from 12 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning.
- **US-13 (Lankford Highway), Accomack County:** Consecutive single-lane closures southbound between Route 179 and Taylor Road. One lane will remain open at all times:
 - September 26-November 29 from 7 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning.
- **Elizabeth River Tunnels/Martin Luther King, Jr. Freeway:** Please check [Elizabeth River Tunnels](#) website for the latest closure and detour information regarding the Downtown Tunnel, Midtown Tunnel and the MLK Freeway.
- **I-564 Intermodal Connector, Norfolk:** Please check <http://www.i564intermodal.com/> for the latest closure/detour information.
- **George Washington Memorial Highway (Route 17), York County:** Crews are widening the road between Route 630 (Wolf Trap Road) and Route 706 (Hampton Highway). Daytime single-lane closures, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and weeknight single-lane closures, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Expect traffic shifts and delays.
