UPDATE: BRIDGE WORK EXTENDED ON TEMAN ROAD IN HANOVER

The structure is located over Pug Swamp Creek

HANOVER – The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) crews continue work to replace the bridge on Teman Rd. (Rt. 738) over Pug Swamp Creek in Hanover County. The road is currently closed to through traffic between Union Church Rd. (Rt. 678) and Verdon Rd. (Rt. 684).

Construction will now extend into the beginning of 2017, weather permitting, due to an error with materials. Two bridge beams were manufactured incorrectly and had to be reordered. The correct beams have arrived and are ready for installation. Supplemental crews are also on-site to expedite construction work.

Drivers should continue to follow the posted detour routes:

- Northbound Teman Rd. (Rt. 738) – Take Beaverdam School Rd. (Rt. 739) west to Beaverdam Rd. (Route 715) north to Union Church Rd. (Rt. 678) east back to Teman Rd. (Rt. 738).
- Southbound Teman Rd. (Rt. 738) – Take Union Church Rd. (Rt. 678) west to Beaverdam Rd. (Route 715) south to Beaverdam School Rd. (Rt. 739) east back to Teman Rd. (Rt. 738).
