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## **VERTICAL HEIGHT CLEARANCE REDUCED ON I-95 SOUTH AT SCOTT ROAD BRIDGE IN HENRICO**

*Overheight vehicles impacted; use I-295 as alternate route until further notice*

**HENRICO**—The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) reduced the vertical height clearance of the Scott Road bridge over Interstate 95 south in Henrico County as the result of a vehicular bridge strike on the morning of Tuesday, September 20. Following an immediate structural inspection, bridge engineers found damage to the exterior beam, which requires the bridge to be posted to reduced height of 14 feet.

“The integrity of the structure is intact,” says Jeff Hill, district bridge engineer. “We’ll complete additional inspections to determine a repair schedule within the coming weeks.”

Overheight vehicles are encouraged to use I-295 as an alternate route until further notice. Additionally, the Scott Road bridge is closed until further notice. Drivers are encouraged to use an alternate route.
