Questions & Answers:

- Q. Under the Scope of work on Page 3, the RFP states that “all underwater bridge inspection teams shall include at least one team member designated as the Underwater Bridge Inspection Dive Supervisor who has a minimum of five years of commercial diving experience.” Is the Dive Supervisor required to hold an ADCI Dive Supervisor Card? If not, is commercial dive training from a dive school required or is experience the only requirement?
- A. The individual designated as a Dive Supervisor is not required to hold a Dive Supervisor certification card from any organization. However, the individual must meet the minimum qualifications for an Underwater Bridge Inspection Diver, also outlined on Page 3 in the RFP. The requirements for training, certification and/or experience of a Diving Supervisor shall not be less than those same requirements for the Divers under his or her charge. All training, certification, and/or experience is subject to review and approval by the Department.

A Revised RFP **will not be published**. The Expression of Interest due date and all other information will remain the same.
