RE: Transportation Enhancement Program Policy Changes

As a follow up to my letter in September which outlined that changes in this program were being considered, I wanted to inform you the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) formally adopted a new policy regarding the allocation of Transportation Enhancement Funds at their November CTB meeting. The proposed policy change focuses on the following goals:

- Focusing resources on completing existing projects
- Applying any funding for new projects to those that promote core transportation functions
- Modifying policy to better enable projects to reach completion

The changes approved will be implemented over a period of 2 years. The changes that are effective immediately and will be applied to applications received December 1st are as follows:

- Increasing the minimum allocation for selected projects from 25% to 50%
- Fully funding any project selected that is estimated to cost \$200,000 or less

The other changes will be implemented next year or the following year. The CTB resolution adopting the revised policy is available for review on VDOT's Enhancement page on our website at:
