



Overview and purpose of the Committee


Structure:

Purpose:

- Provides an official avenue of communications between VDOT's Bike/Ped Program and stakeholders
- BPAC Committee will improve the quality of the VDOT Bike/Ped Program by soliciting public input:
 - Identifying high bicycle use road sections that would benefit from shoulders
 - "Gap Map" identifying small gaps in bike/ped network in each district
 - Keeping program abreast of local issues
 - Providing input on priorities
 - Reporting maintenance needs i.e. missing US Bike Routes signs etc.
