Find out about the proposed plans to improve the intersection of Routes 11 and 107 in the Chilhowie area of Smyth County. The project includes adding a left turn lane from Route 107 north and southbound onto Route 11 and provide ample space at the intersection for large trucks to turn at the intersection.
