



**Route 208 (Courthouse Road) and
Route 636 (Hood Drive)
Intersection Improvement
Spotsylvania County
Notice of Willingness**

A Notice of Willingness about proposed improvements at the Route 208 (Courthouse Road) and Route 636 (Hood Drive) intersection in Spotsylvania County is being offered.

This project will build additional turn lanes on northbound Hood Drive to reduce congestion. A raised median will be built on Hood Drive to separate northbound and southbound traffic between Courthouse Road and McGowan Drive. Additional sidewalk, crosswalks, and pedestrian crossing equipment will be installed at the intersection.

During construction, southbound Hood Drive traffic will be closed to through traffic, and through traffic will be detoured to use Courthouse Road and Route 1 (Jefferson Davis Highway).

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Ms. Anastasia Kapitan, Project Manager, Virginia Department of Transportation, 87 Deacon Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22405 **on or prior to September 25, 2020**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time, and place of the hearing will be posted.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed improvements on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places are included in the environmental documentation.
