## Public Meeting



This project is part of the Richmond Gateway project to improve the landscape at select I-64 and I-95 interchanges in Richmond.**

This public information meeting is being held to provide an opportunity for individuals or organizations to give VDOT comments and/or suggestions on the proposed project. ## Project Overview



**Anticipated cost** – \$730,000

**Purpose** – Landscape the I-95/I-64 corridor at 5<sup>th</sup> Street

**From** – Exit 75 along I-95 north (I-64 east exit)

**To** – 1/2 mile south of Chamberlayne Ave. along I-95 north (1st Street bridge)

**Anticipated start** – Advertise: Summer 2013  
Construction: Fall 2013

# PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The primary purpose of this project is to beautify the landscape along the I-95/I-64 corridor at the 5<sup>th</sup> Street interchange. The landscaping will include improvements at approaches and exits between the Shockoe Valley Bridge, Leigh Street viaduct and 1<sup>st</sup> Street. In addition, gateway or "welcome" signs may be included at sites to be determined.

During construction, minimal traffic impacts are expected. Work will be performed within the existing right of way. No work will take place in the travel lanes.

This project is being funded through a combination of federal and matching funds.

## Environmental Review

Federal funding is being proposed for construction of this project. Therefore, environmental investigations under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) will be conducted.

## Right of Way

The project does not anticipate the acquisition of any right of way or easements.
