**Find out** about the proposed intersection improvements to Route 151 (Rockfish Valley Highway) at Routes 635 (Rockfish School Lane) and 638 (Avon Road) in Nelson County. The Route 635 proposed project starts 0.156 miles south of Route 635 and ends 0.071 miles north of Route 635. The Route 638 starts 0.140 miles south of Route 638 and ends 0.130 miles north of Route 638. The proposed projects involve the construction of a left turn lane from Route 151/6 at each intersection and a right turn lane at Route 638.

**Review** the proposed project plans and the Programmatic Categorical Exclusion documentation at VDOT's Lynchburg District Office located at 4219 Campbell Ave. in Lynchburg, 434-947-6559. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of personnel to answer your questions.

Property impact information, relocation assistance policies and tentative construction schedules are available for your review at the above address and will be available at the public hearing.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed improvements on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places are included in the National Environmental Policy Act documentation.
