The proposed improvements are in connection with the proposed Maryland Transportation Authority project to replace the Route 301 bridge over the Potomac River. The Governor Harry W. Nice Memorial/Senator Thomas “Mac” Middleton Bridge connects Maryland and Virginia at the King George County line.

Stop by between 5-7 p.m. to review the proposed plans and environmental review documents related to the Virginia portion of the project. Project plans are also available for review at VDOT’s Fredericksburg District Office at 87 Deacon Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22405, in Stafford County. Please call 540-899-4288 ahead of your visit to ensure appropriate personnel are available to answer your questions.

Property impact information and tentative construction schedules are available for your review at the District Office and will be available at the public hearing.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed project on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places is provided in the environmental documentation.
