

WHAT'S NEXT?

Field work is currently underway to assess wetlands, streams, threatened and endangered species, wildlife and habitat, historic properties, community facilities, and other resources. This data will be documented and used to help inform the future study, including the identification of impacts of the proposed alternatives.

Next, using data collected and input gathered from the online survey, VDOT will develop the preliminary Purpose and Need to present to concurring, cooperating and participating agencies. This fall, VDOT will work to develop a range of concepts that potentially address those needs. The alternative concepts will be presented to the public in Spring 2021.
