## **ROUTE 621 BRIDGE OVER PASSENGER SWAMP REPLACEMENT PROJECT NOW COMPLETE**

*Project completed on-budget and ahead of schedule*

**ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY**– On Thursday, December 22, crews with the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) completed a project to replace the Route 621 bridge over Passenger Swamp. The road is reopened to traffic.

Crews demolished, removed and replaced the bridge. Also, the approach roadway was rebuilt to tie into the new bridge. The new bridge has been elevated and is 77 feet long and 24 feet wide. There is no longer a weight limit on the new bridge.

The project began on June 28, 2016, and was completed on-budget and ahead of the scheduled completion date of June 2017.
