

**Route 601
(Blue Ridge Mountain Road)
Through Truck Traffic Restrictions
Clarke County**

Notice is hereby given that the Virginia Department of Transportation is accepting written comments through March 8, 2021, regarding the restriction of through truck traffic along Route 601 (Blue Ridge Mountain Road) in Clarke County.

The proposed 11.0-mile restricted section of Route 601 (Blue Ridge Mountain Road) will begin Route 50 (John Mosby Highway) and end at Route 7 (Harry Byrd Highway).

An alternate truck route is proposed to begin on Route 50 traveling west to Route 340 (Lord Fairfax Highway), then traveling north on Route 340 to Route 7, then traveling east on Route 7 to Route 601. The alternate route is 24.7 miles.
