



**Corridor Q: Route 460/121
Poplar Creek Phase B (Buchanan County)
Virtual Location & Design Public Hearing**

Find out about the proposed location and design for Corridor Q: Route 460/121 Poplar Creek Phase B in Buchanan County, a 1.78-mile section of highway to be constructed beginning at the east end of Route 460/121 Poplar Creek Phase A section near Route 604 (Poplar Creek Road) and ending at existing Route 460 in Grundy. The project includes a proposed bridge that crosses the Levisa Fork River and an at-grade intersection with existing Route 460. This project will involve a change and/or break in limited access control.

The hearing will be held as a virtual/online event, accessed from the website link above. VDOT representatives will make a short presentation beginning at 5 p.m. followed by a questions and answer/comment period for approximately one hour after the presentation. The presentation will be available for review throughout the comment period. **Additionally, there will be a virtual question and answer session in advance of the public meeting on May 11, 2021 at 5 p.m.**
