Find out about proposed improvements to the 4.6-mile section of Interstate 81 between mile marker 221.45 and 225.6 in Augusta County near the city of Staunton.

Come see the plans for widening I-81 northbound and southbound from two lanes to three lanes in each direction between exit 221 (I-64 interchange) and exit 225 (Route 262/ Woodrow Wilson Parkway).

Review the proposed project plans and the National Environmental Policy Act document in the form of a Categorical Exclusion (CE) at the public hearing or at VDOT's Staunton District Office located at 811 Commerce Road in Staunton, VA 24401-9029, 540-332-9075 or 1-800-367-7623, TTY/TDD 711. You can also review the project information at VDOT's Harrisonburg Residency Office at 3536 North Valley Pike, Harrisonburg, VA 22802, 540-434-2586. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions. Property impact information, relocation assistance policies and tentative construction schedules are available for your review at the above address and will be available at the public hearing.
