

LABOR DAY 2021

VDOT will lift most lane closures for holiday travel from noon Friday, Sept. 3, until noon Tuesday, Sept. 7. However, motorists may encounter semi-permanent work zones or travel delays in VDOT's Hampton Roads District in the following locations:

City of Norfolk/City of Hampton

HRBT Expansion Project (I-64 east and west from Settlers Landing Road to I-564) – Roadway widening. All travel lanes open. Concrete barriers in place along the shoulder throughout the work zone.

City of Chesapeake

I-64 Southside Widening & High Rise Bridge Expansion Project – Widening interstate between I-264/Bowers Hill and Battlefield Boulevard. Speed limit reduced to 55 mph in both directions.

- Libertyville Road will remain closed in both directions at Bainbridge Boulevard for the new High Rise Bridge construction.
- Military Highway lane capacity has been reduced to one lane in each direction at the I-64 interchange for bridge construction.

City of Newport News

Route 173 – Replacing bridge on Route 173 (Denbigh Boulevard) over I-64. Bridge traffic reduced to one lane in each direction. Access to Denbigh Boulevard from Richneck Road closed.

York County

I-64 Widening Segment III Project – Widening interstate from Route 199/Humelsine Parkway (exit 242) to Route 199/Lightfoot (exit 234). Speed limit reduced to 55 mph in both directions through the work zone.

- Consecutive, long-term full ramp closures on Route 143 (Merrimac Trail) north to I-64 west. Follow posted detour.
- Consecutive, long-term full ramp closure and diversion on the existing Route 199 west on-ramp to I-64 west in Lightfoot. Follow posted detour to temporary median crossover.

James City County

Route 612 Longhill Road Widening Project – Widening Longhill Road from east of Williamsburg West Drive to Glenburnie Road. Speed limit reduced to 35 mph in both directions through the work zone.

Southampton County

Route 671 Bridge Replacement at the Nottoway River - Route 671 between Shady Brook Trail and Buckhorn Drive is closed with a signed detour in place.

Additional Information
